

Request for Your Cooperation in Preventing Hospital-Acquired Infections

Although measures against COVID-19 have been eased and the wearing of masks is now left to “individual discretion,” the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare recommends wearing a mask when receiving medical care or visiting a medical institution. Our hospital cares for many patients who are seriously ill with various diseases, as well as patients with weakened immunity who are prone to becoming severely ill if they contract an infection. For this reason, in order to protect patients, their families, and all visitors from hospital-acquired infections, we continue to implement certain infection control measures, including the wearing of masks. We ask for your cooperation with the following when you visit.

Mask wearing and hand sanitizing	When visiting the hospital, please wear a non-woven mask and sanitize your hands. 
Questionnaire	At your first visit, you will be asked to complete an “Infectious Disease Questionnaire.” Even after your first visit, you may be asked to complete the questionnaire as needed.

In addition, **if you have a fever or cold-like symptoms (such as cough, phlegm, or sore throat), please notify the reception counter.**
