- Regarding Document 2-4 need to be verified as identical to original by the director of Osaka Metropolitan University Hospital.
 - 1. An application form for permission for the training attached with revenue stamps equivalent to 15,300 yen and a photo of the applicant
 - 2. A copy of the residence certificate or one of the following (1)-(3) identification documents (when applying prior to entering Japan, only (3) is to be submitted).
 - (1) Passport (2) Residence Card (3) Certificate of Eligibility
 - 3. A copy of the medical license (or the certificate of graduation from a medical school if the trainee comes from a country where the medical license is not issued)
 - 4. An original or a copy of the certificate to prove that the applicant has at least three years of clinical experience (this must be issued by the director of the hospital that the applicant was affiliated with). Note that the document made by the applicant is not acceptable.
 - 5. A copy of an insurance contract of liability for damage and a copy of the provisions of the policy, or a copy of a certificate of agreement and a document verifying to purchase liability insurance, or a written oath from the director of the hospital where the advanced clinical training is to be conducted which states that the institution will compensate for damages in place of the applicant.

Note that it will be necessary to consult with an official of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare before making the application if the applicant submits a letter promising to purchase liability insurance.

- 6. A medical certificate issued by a physician
- 7. Advanced clinical training plan and a Letter of acceptance
- 8. Two photos (3 cm height and 2 cm width) showing the whole of the face and without anything covering the head taken within the past 6 months
